

DUAL ENROLLMENT/CREDIT

Students enrolling and completing semester Dual Enrollment courses (defined as those arranged between Patrick Henry Academy and colleges and universities), may be awarded graduation credits, with advance permission of the school directors, as follows:

- Patrick Henry Academy will grant credit according to the SC Uniform Grading Scale.
- Students enrolling in other college or university courses not designated as Dual Enrollment will not receive high school credit.
- Parents are responsible for tuition and fees charged by other educational institutions. All fees assessed by external institutions will have no impact on a family's financial obligations to PHA.
- A senior student will be allowed to take a maximum of two college courses per semester to be taught at Patrick Henry Academy.
- Concurrent credit will be given for successful passage of each course. The college will grant appropriate credit per semester.
- Senior parents must be notified that some universities and/or their constituent colleges will not accept these college credits.
- Parents are responsible for tuition and fees charged by other educational institutions. All fees assessed by external institutions will have no impact on a family's financial obligations to PHA.
