

# REQUIREMENTS FOR PROMOTION

Promotion to the next higher grade is contingent upon completion of certain requirements.

- Grades K5 – 4: In order to promote to the next grade or be retained in the current grade, the following will be considered: Concept-based report card, Dominic Reading Level, ERB CTP results and teacher recommendation.
- Grades 5 – 12: In order to promote to the next grade/class or be retained in the current grade/class, the following will be considered: class averages of 70, ERB CTP results (if applicable) and teacher recommendation.
- Grades 1-7: If a student fails reading or math or any two other subjects, he/she fails the grade. If unusual circumstances are involved that may have caused the failure, an appeal to the Board of Directors will be allowed.
- After entering the 8<sup>th</sup> grade a student has five years to complete the required units of work for his/her diploma. Reference: Policy #305

## ACADEMIC FAILURE

Failing courses may result in scheduling conflicts which may prevent a student from being able to follow the normal sequence of courses and which may make impossible the earning of graduation credits during regular school terms.
